Virginia Tech, a leading research university in the Commonwealth of Virginia, welcomes applications and nominations for the next Dean of the Pamplin College of Business.

This is an exceptional opportunity to guide an accomplished college that has made significant investments in students, faculty, and facilities. Students enjoy an innovative curriculum and top programs in Finance, Marketing, Real Estate, Cybersecurity, Entrepreneurship, Hospitality and more. Accomplished senior faculty have been hired to lead research groups, mentor junior faculty, interact with industry, and energize the classroom. New experiential learning opportunities are facilitated by the new Global Business and Analytics Complex (GBAC), the first building of which will open this May, followed by three additional buildings over the next few years, which will include spaces for learning, research, and student living.
